Repentance from Dead Works

Heb 6:1 "Not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works..."

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I am going to bring something out in a very few words that we all must understand. Have you ever asked the Holy Spirit to show you what repentance from dead works means? What repentance from dead works is? Many years ago I asked that question. I have run into leaders in the church that claim to understand what I tell them but won't and don't teach it. I simply believe they won't teach it because they don't really know what repentance from dead works is. So if you will allow me to try and write it for you to read I believe you will begin to see what true repentance from dead works is.

1. The first thing we must understand is repentance. I think all of us do understand what repentance is but let's touch on it for a second. To repent "from" something means you are "doing" something and you want or need to repent "from" it. When you repent "from" that thing you are "doing" is to stop "doing" that thing turn around and go the opposite direction. Agreed? OK let's go on.

2. We are told in Hebrews 6 that "dead works" is that thing that we need to repent "from". Most of the main line denominations in America say that this means we are to repent from sin. Now keep in mind Paul says this is ONE of the principles of the doctrines of Christ so a brand new believer should be taught this right out of the chute. All of us should have been taught this doctrinal principle the first month in Sunday school. But were we? No!

The apostle John writes that if we say we have no sin we are liars and the truth is not in us. If we repented from sin then we should be able to say we have no sin. Are you following me? I trust you do. So that can only mean that "dead works", the thing we should have repented "from" is **not** sin. Shocker huh! I told you this was going to be in few words and I meant it because this is not rocket science. It's the gospel and the gospel is simple, very simple. Dead works is works that are dead. What are dead works? Dead works is trying to be righteous by doing something. If we were supposed to repent from dead works we did **not** repent from sin but repented from trying to work our way into God's grace and not receive it by faith through the sacrifice of His Son.

The first foundational stone that the body of Christ should be built upon is understanding that we need to repent from thinking we can do a work that will be acceptable to God in place of the work of Y'shua/Jesus. Repentance from dead works is simply to stop going about trying to establish our own righteousness. If you will look in Hebrews 5: 13 you will see that the very thing that kept them from being teachers is the fact that they were unskillful in the **word of righteousness** and were in need of milk. They still did not understand, even though they were born again, that there was nothing they could do to help themselves into the Kingdom. The thing that kept them from grasping this sort of repentance was their traditions. They were entering back into animal sacrifice and sprinkling of blood, trying to do what had always been done and what had always been done had been done away with (those blood sacrifices and other such ordinances). Paul wanted to write to them about the importance of understanding that the Levitical priesthood not being necessary and that the order of the Melchisadec priesthood had been re-established in its place. But he couldn't write much to them about it because they were not able to hear it yet simply because they were not standing on the first foundational stone of repentance from dead works.

Here, as they say, in a nutshell is what I believe we must begin to walk on. We have been taught that when we were born again we repented from sin. Because we have been taught that every time we do sin the devil can bring condemnation because we think we should have repented from it. So we “try” and repent from it again and again and again. Then there comes a time when we either begin to hide it or just plain quit trying to live what we have been taught should be a Christian life. Is there any wonder why there is little to no power in the church? When the truth really sinks in that true repentance from dead works is not repenting from sin you will be made free. Jesus made you righteous, you were shown there was nothing you could do but freely accept Him as your sacrifice and resurrected savior, and no matter who you were that day you repented from trying to work your way into heaven. You repented from dead works. You can’t repent from sin in the flesh you have now. You can confess it as sin to Him knowing He is faithful and just to forgive you of that sin but He is your righteousness. Get on the first stone that the builders rejected or it will crush you. He is the only one that can hold that weight stop trying to pick it up.

Prepare Ye the Way

*Gen 2:5 And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there was **not a man to till the ground.***

In a study of the sower who sowed seed (Matthew 13, Mark 4, and Luke 8); the condition of the ground is vital to the success of the seed. If the ground is hard packed then the birds will immediately consume the seed. If the ground is rocky the seed will have very little yield. If the ground is full of thorns and briars the seed is choked out. If on the other hand the fallow ground is plowed, the rocks removed and thorns pulled up and the ground prepared then the seed can produce as it was intended. Y’shua/Jesus told his disciples (and us) that by understanding this parable we could understand all his parables. (Mark 4:13)

In Genesis the Creator Father gives us seed and specifies just how seed works.

Gen 1:11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.

Gen 1:29 And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for meat.

He doesn’t describe seed in such detail just to hear Himself speak; he is educating us and qualifying the properties of seed for our benefit and also to put limitations on the adversary. We also see in 1 Cor 15:37-38 *And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not that body that shall be, but bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other grain: But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.*

Remember this one thing always: God is NEVER taken by surprise. God is truly the ONLY all knowing, all seeing, and ever-present one. The adversary can NOT be in all places at all times. (Hallelujah!) He also doesn’t have all knowledge and isn’t all-powerful. He has to depend upon only 1/3 of the angelic forces, he has to come and go because there are so many humans to control or keep captive. (You may notice that you aren’t always being harassed, it’s because the adversary isn’t omnipresent and can’t maintain 100 percent control!) He is basically a fire starter. He starts something and then has to let the fire do the damage. In the worst situation, God’s living water is waiting and will put out the best fire the adversary starts. The most joyful news is that God mapped the adversary’s fire plan before the foundation of time and created a master plan to stop his work! Old satan was defeated before he began. (Rev. 13:8)

1 John 3:8 For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

Implementing God's plan is man's whole purpose in being. Satan's plan is to distract, dissuade (which also means discourage), and stop the process thereby killing the seed (the man). Great news, by killing the seed he caused God's plan to be implemented! God through Y'shua/Jesus has already defeated him, but the process of the seed that was sown hasn't been completed so the enemy thinks he's still on top of his game. WRONG!

By just a little understanding of farming we can learn huge things about God's kingdom. A farmer tending his crops has to have two qualities at work in his life, faith and patience. Faith that the little things he calls seed will go into the ground and produce a harvest. Patience so that if it looks like no crop is coming forth; he doesn't go out and dig up all his seed to see just where it is in its growth cycle.

The Creator is the most patient of sowers. He has faith that the single seed he called Adam would go into the ground and produce the necessary harvest to destroy the works of the adversary. If one were to examine the crop with natural eyes, one might just be a tad skeptical, but not our God! He has faith in US! He likened saying to sowing and He believes that what He said shall come to pass! It doesn't matter what it looks like in the natural He has faith and patience.

Now back to the preparation.

*Jer 4:3-4 For thus saith the LORD to the men of Judah and Jerusalem, **Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns. Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart,***

*Hos 10:12 Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; **break up your fallow ground:** for it is time to seek the LORD, till he come and rain righteousness upon you.*

Before every move of God intercessors began the preparation of the ground. A messenger from God would be sent to the people to alert them to the times ahead. Here we have examples of two prophets sent by God to warn the people to repent, break up the fallow ground of their hearts and make some changes. Today is no exception. We must see that we are in a real mess as far as sowing goes. We can't sow seed in unprepared soil. We can't sow seed in bad ground. If we expect to "prosper and be in health" such as 3 John 2 teaches, our souls have to prosper first. If our souls are full of guilt and condemnation from sin and self-absorption we won't produce much.

Before Y'shua (the ultimate seed) was sown, God sent John the Baptist to prepare the way. We see in the Torah and the Prophets John and his calling were foretold. Isaiah 40:3, Malachi 3:1 He was the one in the wilderness crying out "Prepare ye the way of the Lord". He was preparing the soil of men's hearts for sowing of Y'shua (the good seed) into those same hearts.

Today men pretty much do the things that are right in their own sight. God set up a master plan before creation and most men are ignorant to it. They do all sorts of things to feel good about themselves, to make themselves happy, to fill the void of God's Holy Spirit in their lives. They do all sorts of religious things in religious ways to be righteous. Of course they fail and never achieve the goal.

God manifested His Son to destroy the works of the adversary. He didn't manifest an angel to do the work. He didn't come down and do it Himself. He created a Son. The Son is just like the Father.

Religious men are trying everywhere to be godly or god-like, but never can come up to God. They tried using the very Laws of God to reach the goal with NO success. So God uses His Word to separate Himself into more than just Himself. That may sound like bad grammar, but what God did in creating children was so awesome English just doesn't explain it very well.

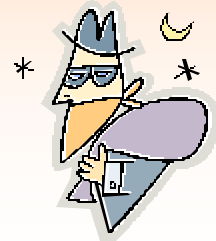
Heb 4:12 For the word of God is quick (alive), and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Here if we look very carefully at these words we can perhaps understand just a small part of God's huge plan. We see God in the beginning speaking words. He begins with an aleph and ends with a tau. He uses these letters to create everything we see. He uses the invisible to manifest the visible, a Son who will till the ground. The Hebrew word used in Genesis 2:5 for *till* is 'abad or in English a bondservant. A bondservant is a servant by choice. Y'shua we're told by John is "the word made flesh". Perhaps a better way of saying this is "the word manifested flesh". God used His own word to divide and multiply Himself. His desire is to have sons, but He was also keenly aware of the adversary and the

opportunity for darkness to stop His plan. He brought forth a Son, the last Adam who would speak His words alone and do His will without reservation. Y'shua had a predecessor who plowed up the fallow ground of men's hearts. Today God wants us to walk as the "manifested Sons of God". Before we can be effective in that calling, we too must prepare the way of the Lord in our own hearts. We need to find repentance from dead works and doing things our own way and come in line with the great master plan of God.

Rom 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

There are many who claim the name of Y'shua who are deceived into thinking that all they have to do to be a son of God is to claim the name and then do whatever they will. When a man is deceived he really doesn't know what he stumbles at. When you claim Y'shua as your Lord you are supposed to be submitted to him as Lord, not just buddy. Even a friend would listen to what his "friend" had to say. Y'shua sits on the right hand of Abba Father where he intercedes for us. He has already given us our jobs. We are in all actuality not our own anymore. We were bought with a price, the price of his life-blood.

Shall we be like Esau who sought long and hard for repentance yet couldn't find it? Shall we sacrifice our birthright for a "bowl of beans"? Is our life all about comfort and consumption? Why do we make money? Is it to buy more and more stuff to fill more and more barns? Wasn't it supposed to be to establish God's covenant upon the earth? Will we answer for the hungry ministers, the starving naked evangelists, and the persecuted members of the Body in other nations and the dead and dying souls all around us? I am pretty confident the answer is YES.

If it feels like you are in the wilderness, perhaps you should stop for just a second and see if the Holy Spirit has brought you to where you are. See if He has been called of Abba Father to draw you to be tested, tried and proved ready to be a son of God. You may not enjoy these words, but if you were just about to be hit an oncoming car wouldn't it be nice if a prophet would say to you "prepare ye the way of the Lord". Remember, he could be saving your skin!

2 Tim 1:7

7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

The Fear Factor

We are at the end of the days of labor on the planet. God told us in *Exodus 20:9* "Six days shalt thou labor, and do all thy work." What that means is that it is real work to live on this planet during the six thousand years man has a lease on the planet, but on the seventh day when Y'shua returns to rule and rein it will be a Sabbath (a rest day). The work we have to do is a work of faith. The only work we have to do today is believe the word of God. If you believe what He says, you'll act accordingly. On the other hand, if you don't believe you'll act in opposition to what God says, pure and simple. It shouldn't be a big surprise to believers that lost men act like the devil; they are using the forces of hell (fear) and acting accordingly. Plus a dead man can't act like a living man. If you trust God completely for your life, your provision and your salvation you must live by faith. Faith believes before it sees. Fear must see before it believes.

Faith is trust based upon love. Fear is worry based upon anything other than love. Our heavenly Father is a creator. He builds, creates, makes, produces and encourages like behavior. The adversary tears down, destroys, ruins and warps what is already created. He isn't an originator so he can only steal what isn't his and twist it.

Men who don't know God don't know love. They don't understand the love God had and how He demonstrated it through the manifestation of His Son Y'shua/Jesus. They are afraid that things are bad and the only way to fix them is to get rid of the ones they see as enemies. Sadly they don't realize that when they walk motivated by fear, they are being used like silly puppets in a play doomed to failure. All of us have the propensity to walk in fear unless we press into the love of God. *Gal 5:6* "... faith

which worketh by love". It is vital to the faith walk, the walk where you trust God and believe what He has told you that you walk by love. Love creates things in men that weren't there before. Love looks at the spirit of a man rather than the outward appearance and acts accordingly.

It's easy to see flaws, failures and shortcomings in our fellow man; these things are inherent to the species. It is not so easy to create what is lacking by "calling those things which be not as though they were". We all know that when we judge one another we don't look at hearts and motives but at behaviors, but expect others to see what we're thinking when we make mistakes. The apostle Paul had great understanding of the principal of creating good in men who didn't look so good. He was so humbled by God's intervening love for him that he willingly laid down his life for the men he served. *2 Cor 5:16-17 "Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more. Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new"*. Again it's a sad thing that folks don't understand these two verses. We can go to church after church and find humans who don't act like new creatures. They don't act dead to sin and alive to righteousness (2 Peter 2:24), they act like they are alive to sin and dead to righteousness.

If I stand in the bathroom and look in the mirror chances are good I wouldn't see a person who looks like a "new creation". I have to really love myself and call those things which be not as though they were. I have to remind myself that Y'shua died for my sins and now I have exchanged my sin self for his holy self! I have to do this day in and day out. Why? Because I get afraid that I'm not so righteous and that I'm not such a new creation after all.

It seems silly to have to remind myself that I have an invisible adversary who preys on my mind so that I will fear, but I do. King David did the same for himself when he wrote Psalm 103. He said "Bless the Lord (empower the Lord) O my soul and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the Lord O my soul and forget not all His benefits". God is love and God wants lovely things for His children. Faith is the force founded on love whereby we obtain the lovely things He has for us. If the adversary keeps us bound in fear we shall never obtain them. Let's stir ourselves up in faith and love and keep fear at bay every second of every moment of every hour of every day!

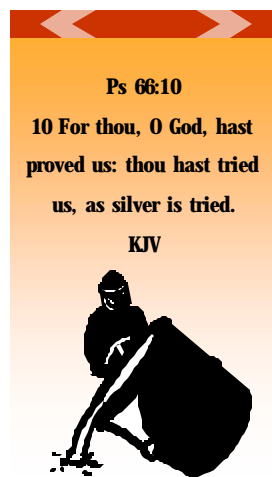


Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness, which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost.

loud signal that this certain group of people that had received Jesus as their savior had entered into trying to go about establishing their own righteousness and Paul was led of the Holy Ghost to warn them of the imminent danger in doing so. As I read the letter to the Hebrews I don't see evidence that anyone had actually renounced Jesus as their Lord but must have been mighty close to doing just that for Paul to write some of the things he wrote. But now 2000 years later I meet people that in fact have come onto some revelation (from an angel of light) that Jesus was not God that He was not the Messiah in the flesh only a man sent to show us how to live on earth. NO! NO! NO! That is a subtle lie but a lie nonetheless.

1 John 2:22-23 who is a liar but he that denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist that denies the Father and the Son. Whosoever denies the Son; the same hath not the Father.

More than likely they were what today is being taught as Torah observant and Jesus didn't even mention it. Why? Because He was Torah made flesh and they were observing Him.

If you want to be Torah observant and please God the Father realize that the Torah you observe is Jesus. Don't be lead into the pasture with no life growing in it. Jesus is the way the truth and the life that all of us needed and that most of the world still needs and must receive. Quit working so hard on becoming what Jesus made you (righteous) and start putting all that effort into getting the people around you into the Kingdom of God! Remember I write this because I love you.

Let There Be Darkness?

In these days of what looks like total darkness it is more vital than ever that we believe God's word by faith (trust without initial natural evidence) and not by sight. It's also important that we trust the Holy Spirit to confirm the word we believe in by the promised signs that follow. Let's do something totally wacky and imagine God looking on our world and acting like the normal Christian acts. The average Christian would look around and say "Gee it's dark out there". If God had acted like most of

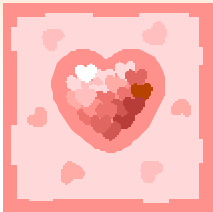

us in the creation, we'd all be doomed to live in total darkness forever. In Genesis however, the book of beginnings, God looked out and saw darkness and did something totally different, He said "Let there be light" or in a more literal translation of the Hebrew text He said "Light be".

The life of the spirit-filled believer is one that is totally opposite to the world. Our job is to "Call those things which be not as thou they were". We are called to be like the Creator. We are to be like Father Abraham, the Father of faith. Remember, the Son of God was manifested to destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8). Everything the spirit-filled believer does is upstream, against the flow, and 180 degrees out of everything worldly.

If we took the word "manifested" in 1 John 3:8 and looked it up in the Greek we'd see that it is the word "phanero-o", which means to render apparent. In the world of 3D animation, computers are used to take line drawings and "render them" so they look like the real thing. Since before the foundation of time God has been preparing the way of the Lord or manifesting (rendering apparent) His Son. He first created language and then began speaking what His Son would do. He spoke of Y'shua in Genesis and continued all the way through the book written by the prophet Malachi. Y'shua called himself the aleph and the tav. 1 John tells us that Y'shua was God's word made flesh. He was the light of the world that destroyed the darkness that hasatan brought.

Among my many questions to God is this one; "Why did Y'shua leave us here when he had said, It is finished"? We seem to be so helpless. His answer has been slow and methodical in its coming. He wanted me to not only have the answer, but understand it as well. Anytime God allows us revelation, He wants it to "stick" so He doles it out in line with the amount of study and prayer we put to the subject. This way when we pass the information onto you, we can do it clearly and easily for all in the Body to understand.

First, we must remember we have an adversary who has "acquired" the rights to the planet and all its contents for seven thousand natural years because of Adam's rebellion. Sure Y'shua bought it all back with his pure life, the ransom he paid with his lifeblood and the power of his resurrection. Secondly, God honors His word. His word is the same yesterday, today and forever. He gave man a lease on His creation for seven thousand years, pure and simple. Then man voluntarily gave it to the adversary. We are all basically waiting out the lease agreement that God made with man. The really awesome thing is that God controls the clock!

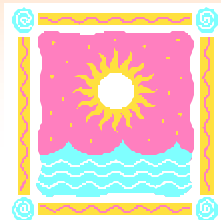
Mark 13:20 And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days.

I know I'm keenly aware that time is passing at a really fast rate. God also shortened the lifespan of a man to 120 years. Imagine living as long as Adam or Methuselah? Nine hundred years of darkness is not an attractive proposition to me.

Let's go back to earth just before Y'shua left us here. He gave his disciples instructions to "Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel". He basically asked those of us left here to finish out the lease to "pass the good news on that he paid out the lease". The lease time had to be honored by God, but the consequences of subletting the planet to satan have been done away with. Another thing to note is that the natural bodies we live in belong to this corrupted planet so they have to return to it. That means natural death has to happen. This sounds kind of morbid unless you understand that our natural bodies are only the shells of our real selves. These bodies are like seeds and once they are "planted" they can be raised to be like Y'shua, glorified. (Take time to study 1 Corinthians 15). The job left us by Y'shua was better accomplished by many sons as apposed to one. By him leaving the Holy Spirit could be distributed amongst a body rather than in a single human form. There are days we'd rather sink back into bed, pull the covers over our heads and sing "Make the world go away". The really exciting thing is that if we really believe what Y'shua said, God wants to manifest Himself through mere human flesh. He wants to do greater works through us. If we can get past the everyday darkness that surrounds us and see the light of God shining to us, we will see the glory of the Lord. If we will stand up and believe we are already healed, freed, strengthened, and empowered we will be the manifested sons of God! There is nothing in this world to compare with the manifestation of God's presence working in us! Let's all say together, "Light be".
